PC Eastwood spoke about crime prevention, and how members of public should take photographs of their valuables, as it is not always easy to describe or remember exactly what they look like in the event of a theft. Also, how simple jobs like changing hinges on out building to ones that cover the screws, and cctv can help prevent crime in some cases.
