In relation to the A326 improvements, once the results of this consultation have been analysed a preferred option will be selected and set out in the November report mentioned above. Feasibility design work will then be undertaken and another public consultation on the preferred option will be carried out, likely in early 2022. This consultation will include more detailed information on the design of the proposals and there will be an opportunity to provide detailed feedback and influence updates to the design before it proceeds to a potential planning application. It is however very important to note that at this stage the scheme is still subject to obtaining government funding, firstly to develop the scheme further and secondly to deliver the scheme. For this we need to make a series of business cases setting out the relative costs and benefits of any scheme to be implemented, a process that is currently ongoing.
